Principal's Message

Hello DMS families.

Reminder: Dunsmuir is a Closed Campus for Students: Please remind your student(s) that Dunsmuir is a closed campus. This means that students cannot leave the school property from the time they are dropped off to the time they leave at the end of the day. We have had some students trying to leave the school property to visit the bakery or store before school starts in the mornings. Please let your student know that this in not allowed. Thank you.
