Please see below for some important information:

<u>June 26, Wednesday</u> – this is the final day of regular instruction; students will clean out their lockers and take home all of their belongings at the end of this day. Students should be sure to bring backpacks to school so they can transport all their belongings home at the end of the day.

<u>June 27, Thursday</u> – school will be in session and students are welcome to attend as supervi[®]sion will be available and typical support will be in place. Please be aware that this day is dedicated to the final cleaning of classrooms, the moving of furniture, final clean out of lock[®]ers and final pick up of belongings in the event that things were left behind. Start-Up Schedule for 2024-2025 Gradual Grade Entry

Please see below for start-up information and the specific times your child will attend for the first week next school year. The Bus Schedule will be as follows:

September 3 - buses will run in the morning (pick-up) and at 11:31 for Grade 6 students who ride the bus.

September 4 - buses will run in the morning (pick-up) and after school (drop-off)

**on September 4, Grade 7 students who ride the bus will need a way home at 11:31 and Grade 8 students who ride the bus will need a way to school at 12:06.

Thank you for your support and understanding as we work towards getting each student oriented to the new school year in the most organized and calm manner possible. Week 1

<u>Tuesday- September 3– 8:45-11:31 Grade 6 students ONLY -</u> will meet in the gym where they can check the class lists (alpha lists will be posted), meet their teacher in the line (in the gym) and be guided to their classroom to begin the Welcome and Orientation for the school year.

<u>Wednesday- September 4- 8:45-11:31- Grade 7 Students ONLY</u> - students will arrive at the school and check the posted class lists for their name. Once they know whose class they are in and the room # they are in, they will make their way to that location. Staff will be in the hallways to assist students and direct them to their classrooms. **please note, students will be dismissed at 11:31 am and will need a way home at this time as there are no buses.

<u>Wednesday- September 4- 12:06-2:41 - Grade 8 Students ONLY</u>- students will arrive at the school and check the posted class lists for their name. Once they know whose class they are in and the room #, they will make their way to that location. Staff will be in the hall-ways to assist students and direct them to their classroom.

<u>Thursday- September 5- 8:45-2:41 -whole school in attendance- Regular schedule</u> Friday- September 6- Planning for a Whole School BBQ. Students should bring water and clothing suitable for being outside for the afternoon. Sunscreen recommended.
