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Athletics

This is a reminder or introduction to parents new to DMS that in order to participate in Athletics (School Sports) at DMS, parents need to complete the permission form and pay athletic fees if your student is playing a fall sport including cross country, ultimate, soccer, or touch rugby,

Please pay the DMS Athletic Participation Fee online School Cash Online.

Every school year, each student who participates on a school sports team is asked to pay a \$40 fee. This fee is paid once per year and applies regardless of if your child plays on one team or three. All families can also log on and order a FREE digital Pictures2Protect Card. More about the Pictures2Protect program here.

Heads up: In the email communication to schools that says the photos are ready on the Lifetouch Portal, it also says that photos are ready to be viewed and ordered on line.
